David Pullen reviewed the proposed Local Law Number 2 of 2019 entitled “Town of Belfast Solar Energy Systems and Facilities Local Law”. The purpose of the proposed local law is to allow the Town to regulate and control the construction and establishment of solar energy systems and facilities in the Town.

Representatives from the Town of Angelica stated that Angelica would be in favor of sharing costs and services going forward with the solar project. This would include, but not be limited to, engineering services (if needed), attorney fees and a joint public hearing.

The Local Law was approved by a motion by Councilman Jennings and a second by Councilman Cole. All in favor. Carried
